

## Level 7 – NVQ Diploma Construction Senior Management

### Unit Selection

The level 7 NVQ Diploma in **Construction Senior Management** is made up from the units shown below. You are required to complete a minimum of 169 **Credit Units**.

This comprises the 6 mandatory units as well as optional units from the 3 optional groups.

The balance between the **Mandatory** and **Optional** units is intended to design a qualification that includes:

The necessary core competences for a practitioner at Level 7 NVQ Diploma

A reflection of your particular job functions

A balance between your technical and personal competences

You must produce evidence from the workplace to meet the requirements of these construction management standards.

However some candidates may need to widen their current job roles to achieve this evidence. This is consistent with the notion that a Vocational Qualification should be diagnostic, development and qualifying

A unit specific evidence signpost list will be created. This will provide you with a list of potential evidence which you can begin to gather and present to your assessor at your first assessment visit.
